5th Annual Lumber Jack Split & Stack Event

- When:** Saturday, October 8th. Registration starts at 8:30 am.
- Where:** Pembina Valley Bible Camp
- Who:** Register a team of 7. Participants 16 & up welcome. (Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian attend the event.)
- What:** Teams will work their way through a pile of logs that have been cut into 8' lengths. The logs will need to be cut into approximately 18" lengths, then split and stacked.
- *Teams are asked to bring their own chainsaws and splitters if possible.*

The Grand Prize

A Stihl Chainsaw.

The entry fee is \$25/person; however for every additional \$25.00 you fund raise you'll receive additional entries for the grand prize draw. (Ex: \$100.00 raised, your name is entered four times)

Prizes and Give-a-ways

The team that cuts & splits the most wood will win prizes, as well as a prize will be awarded to the best lumberjack dressed participant and the best beard. There will also be some draw prizes.

What's the purpose and where are the funds going?

Wood is the camp's main source of heat through the winter months, and as such, a large quantity is needed (approx 70 cords/year). This event will serve two purposes, one being to cut and split a year's supply of firewood, and the second is to raise funds to cover the maintenance of our heating equipment.

When Fundraising:

- All donations over \$10.00 will be receipted.
- Neatly print all information for every donor.
- Collect all your pledges and bring the monies raised with you to registration on the day of the event.
- Each person must register for the event with their team, but collect funds with their own pledge sheet.

- Event will begin at 9:30am
- ½ hour coffee break provided at 11:00am
- Split and Stack event will end around 1:00pm.
- Lunch will be served at the dining hall along with our closing words and prizes.

Bringing Your Own Chainsaw &/or Log Splitter:

- PVBC has a limited amount of chainsaw's & log splitters available for use, so we're asking all participants to please consider bringing your own. Teams may bring more than one saw to the event; however only one saw will be used at a time per team. The log splitters must be free standing (not attached to tractors) and must be manually operated (no constant motion splitters).
- PVBC does not take responsibility for participants operating equipment. All participants under 18 years of age are required to have a parent or guardian on their team.
