

Pembina Valley Bible Camp

25th Annual Ride-A-Thon



When: Friday, Saturday and Sunday, September 13 – 15, 2024. Check in for the trail ride will be open from 6:45-7:15pm on Friday, September 13, 2024 and from 8:30-9:30am on Saturday, September 14, 2024. If you are unable to attend the whole weekend, coming for one or two days is always an option!

Where: Pembina Valle Bible Camp

Who: Riders of all ages welcome. Riders 12 and under must be accompanied by a participating adult. Note that this is not a beginner trail ride. Experience is required. All participants must register by September 10, 2024 (see registration details below).

Prizes:

Prizes will be distributed through a tiered fundraising system:

Level 1 – Raise \$300.00 and your name will get put in to win a prize!

Level 2 – Raise \$1000.00 and you will get a ticket to put into a silent auction. Every \$100.00 after the initial \$1000.00 will gain you another ticket. Each person can win up to 2 prizes!

Level 3 – Raise \$2000.00 and you will get a ticket into the Grand Prize Horse draw! Every \$100.00 after the initial \$2000.00 will gain you another ticket (ie. \$2400 = 5 tickets)

**Note: You can choose not to enter the horse draw. Instead, exchange your grand prize ticket for 10 silent auction tickets.*

Fundraising:

Our goal is to raise \$50,000. All funds raised at our 25th Annual Ride-A-Thon will go directly towards our capital barn project. This project includes renovating an existing structure so it can function as our new barn including box stalls, a wash area, storage and bathrooms!

Pledge forms will be emailed to you once your online registration form has been processed.

When fundraising:

- Each person must raise a minimum of \$300 to register and \$400 if you are planning to ride a camp horse
- All donations \$10.00 and over will be receipted
- Neatly print all information for every donor
- Collect all your pledges and bring the money raised when you check in for the event
- Clinics will be offered on Friday Sept 13, 2024 by Jack Dyck, Mariah Andrie and Paul Unrau. Cost varies per clinic (between \$50-\$75)
- Accommodations and clinic slots are first come, first serve.

Horse Use:

Camp Horses:

Camp horses can be reserved in advance through your online registration form. All camp horses will be placed in a trail order by the Head Wrangler and are to remain in that order during the trail ride.

All riders must be confident on horseback. PVBC staff will supervise all camp horse activities throughout the weekend. Riders 12 and under require adult supervision that are not PVBC staff.

IMPORTANT: This trail ride is not a good place to learn how to ride a horse for the first time

Bringing Your Own Horse:

Please bring your own feed and water bucket for your horses. PVBC has a limited amount of penning available for use. Please indicate on your registration form how many horses you are bringing, for which days, and if you require penning.

To make the ride enjoyable for everyone, the trail ride will be at an easy walking pace to help accommodate a wide spectrum of riding ability.

PVBC does not take responsibility for any riders. All riders must sign a waiver and riders 12 and under are required to have adult supervision with them – this does not include PVBC staff (even if they are riding a camp horse).

Registration:

All participants must register by September 10, 2024, This confirms necessary accommodations, use of camp horses (if necessary) and dietary requirements.

All riders participating must sign a waiver form prior to the ride. If the rider is under the age of 18 a parent or guardian must sign for them. Waivers will be emailed to you once your online registration form has been processed.
