Location

Who Can Participate?

- Register a team of 7
- Participants must be 16"
- Anyone under 18 must have a parent or guardian on their team

Event Overview

Teams will:

- Work through a pile of 8' logs
- Cut logs into 18" lengths
- Assemble skids (lumber & hardware provided by PVBC)
- Split and stack wood on a skid

What to Bring

- Cordless impact driver
- Cordless circular saw
- Tape measure
- Chainsaw
- Log splitter (must be free-standing & manually operated)

If you cannot bring tools or a splitter, contact the camp office, 204-246-2008

Entry & Fundraising

- Participant entry free is \$25/person
- Grand Prize: Stihl Chainsaw (donated by GVE)
- Every \$25 raised = 1 entry

Prizes & Awards

- Prizes awarded for:
 - Best dressed lumberjack
 - Best Beard
- All teams compete for the Split'n Stack Trophy based on the 4 criteria
 1. Speed (race to complete 4 stacked skids)
 2. Skid Build Quality
 3. Stacking Quality
 4. Wood Size

Purpose

- Provide PVBC's annual firewood supply to help heat the camp
- Raise funds to maintain heating equipment

Fundraising Guidelines

- Donations over \$10 are receipted
- Neatly record all donor information
- Bring pledge form & funds to registration
- Team leaders register their team members but each participant uses their own pledge form when fundraising

Equipment Safety

- PVBC is not responsible for equipment operation
- Only one chainsaw in use per team at a time
- No tractor-mounted or constant motion splitters allowed
